At our December 1st Union Meeting the ballots were tallied by the election committee and the results were reported at that meeting. The only contested position was for the Office of Business Manager. In our Union Election for Business Manager there were 480 ballots cast. The votes cast were 208 for Richard Lansing and 269 for Steve Breitlow. There were 2 contested ballots and 1 ballot was void. Richard Lansing has filed a protest of our election with the United Association. The immediate effect of that protest is that we have been directed by UA General President Bill Hite to postpone installation of officers indefinitely. The UA General Office will be conducting an investigation

pertaining to the protest filed by Richard Lansing. All current Plumbers Union Local 75 Officers will remain in office until the United Association completes their investigation and makes a final determination.
